

**Devon County Council (Exeter City Centre Area)  
(Traffic Management) Order**

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“Act”) & all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force on \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Exeter City Centre Area) (Traffic Management) Order \_\_\_\_\_”
- 2 Nothing in this order applies to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
- 3 Nothing in this order applies to emergency service vehicles
- 4 The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
- 5 Save as provided in article 6 no person shall cause to be driven a vehicle in the lengths of road specified in schedule 1 other than in the direction specified in that schedule
- 6 Nothing in article 5 applies to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle between midnight and 8am
- 7 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a left turn from the length of road in column 1 of schedule 2, into the length of road in column 2
- 8 Save as provided in article 9, no person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in schedule 3
- 9 Nothing in article 8 applies if the vehicle is:-
  - (a) an emergency service vehicle;
  - (b) an authorised bus;
  - (c) being used with a council permit for essential purposes
- 10 In article 20.2 of Devon County Council (City Centre Area, Exeter) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2015 in sub-paragraph (b) for “a local bus” substitute “a bus”
- 11 The orders in schedule 4 are revoked as specified

**Schedule 1 – One Way Streets**

<b>Dixs Field Western Spur</b>	from its junction with Southernhay East to its junction with Dixs Field	east bound
<b>Southernhay East</b>	from its junction with Barnfield Road to its southern junction with Southernhay West	south bound
