- 2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
- 3. The order in schedule 2 is revoked as specified
- 4. This order comes into force and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Southernhay Area, Exeter) (20mph Zone) Order "
