Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under section 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & of all other enabling powers

- 1. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads specified within schedule 1
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
- 3. The order in schedule 2 is revoked as specified
- 4. This order comes into force 24th January 2019 and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Southernhay Area, Exeter) (20mph Zone) Order 2019"
