## Devon County Council (Rosebarn Lane Area, Exeter) (Residents Parking) Amendment Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce

**No Waiting At Any Time** in sections of Aldrin Road, Armstrong Avenue, Collins Road, Doriam Close, Florida Drive, Mayflower Avenue, Patricia Close, Pennsylvania Road, Rollestone Crescent, Rosebarn Lane & Stoke Valley Road;

Limited Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm 2 Hours No Return Within 4 Hours (Exemption for Residents Zone S4 Permit Holders) in a specified length of Rosebarn Lane;

Limited Waiting Mon-Fri 8am-6pm 2 Hours No Return Within 4 Hours (Exemption for Residents Zone S9 Permit Holders) in specified lengths of Aldrin Road, Collins Road, Doriam Close & Stoke Valley Road;

Pay & Display (Tariff Exeter G1 30 mins free, up to 4 hours £1.70, over 4 hours £3.90) Mon-Fri 8am-6pm (Exemption for Residents Zone S9 Permit Holders) in specified lengths of Collins Road, Pennsylvania Road, Rosebarn Lane & Stoke Valley Road;

Residents Parking (Zonal) Mon-Fri 8am-6pm Zone S9 in specified lengths of Aldrin Road, Armstrong Avenue, Canberra Close, Collins Road, Doriam Close, Falkland Close, Florida Drive, Great Hill View, Linnet Close, Mayflower Avenue, Michigan Way, Newfoundland Close, Patricia Close, Perth Close, Plassey Close, Queensland Drive, Sheppard Road, Stoke Valley Road, The Fairway & Valley Park Close.

Residents, charity business occupier £30 annually, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30, business permits annual cost: 1<sup>st</sup> permit £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> permit £75, 3<sup>rd</sup> permit £150; guest house/hotel visitors permit £30 per batch of 20 permits;

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to the picking up & setting down of passengers, loading/unloading of goods & disabled persons vehicles.
