Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to relocate the crossing point on Bude Street to the junction with Bampfylde Street to improve visibility. This requires an adjustment to the adjacent loading bay that is moving 3 metres further away from the Bampfylde Street junction.

The restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
