

Devon County Council (Quintana Gate, Exeter) (Loading Bay) Amendment Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce on

Bartholomew Street East, Exeter: a new length of LOADING ONLY AT ANY TIME on the south-east side from 13 metres south-west of its junction with Mary Arches Street for 20 metres south-westerly (measured across the front of the layby).

statement of reasons

It is proposed to introduce a length of Loading Only At Any Time in a dedicated layby adjacent to the Quintana Gate development to facilitate loading and unloading for students residing at The Neighbourhood.

The restrictions are proposed to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
