No Waiting At Any Time in specified lengths of Forde Close;

Pay & Display (Tariff Newton Abbot D1) Mon-Sat 8.30am-5.30pm (Exemption for Residents Zone K1 Permit Holders) in specified lengths of Forde Close - 30 mins 30p, 1 hour 60p, 1½ hours £1, 2 hours £1.40, 2½ hours £1.70, 3 hours £2, 3½ hours £2.40, 4 hours £2.70, over 4 hours £7, Sun free;

Residents Parking Mon-Sat 8.30am-5.30pm Zone K1 (Newton Abbot) in specified lengths of Forde Close - residents of 1-50 Forde Close may apply for residents permit £30 each, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30 & essential visitor permits are free.

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods & disabled persons vehicles.

Devon County Council (Forde Close, Newton Abbot) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Revocation Order 5753 to REVOKE **Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Except for Access** on Forde Close.
