Residents, charity business occupier permits £30 annually, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30; annual trade permit £45, short stay trade permits £60 per book of 20, daily trade permit £5, weekly trade permit £25; essential visitor and care worker permits are free. The operation and pricing structure for all parking permits is currently under review which may mean some permits will be issued virtually and prices may increase. Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.
