To INTRODUCE a 30mph speed limit on B3344 (Bovey Road), from a point 33 metres west of its junction with Apple Tree Close to a point 123 metres west of that junction; B3344 (Road from Knighton Heath to The Red House), from a point 73 metres west of its junction with Pipehouse Lane to a point 143 metres west of that junction; B3344 (Plymouth Road), from a point 119 metres east of its junction with Voisey Close to a point 206 metres east of that junction; "Road from Dunscombe Forge to Kiln Close", from its junction with "Road from Claycutters Arms to Arnwood" to a point 68 metres north of that junction.

Statement of Reason:

Currently the majority of Chudleigh Knighton is subject to a 30mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting. This order will extend the speed limit out to the existing 30mph terminal signs on the unlit sections of the three B roads leading into Chudleigh Knighton. The order will also introduce a new section of 30mph limit on the minor road (Road from Dunscombe Forge to Kiln Close) coming into Chudleigh Knighton from the north.

Specifically, the order will facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and will preserve or improve the amenities of the area which the road runs through.
