

**Devon County Council (Ludwell Lane, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles)
Amendment Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1 & 2 and part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Ludwell Lane, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Amendment Order ”
2. Except as provided in article 3, no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, allow a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the schedule
3. Nothing in article 2 shall apply to vehicles that require access to land and premises on Ludwell Lane, provided those vehicles cannot access the land or premises from the Burnthouse Lane/Rifford Road end and provided that the vehicles have been authorised in advance by Devon County Council.
4. The County of Devon (Ludwell Lane, Exeter) (Peak Period - One Way) Order 1997 is hereby revoked
