Exeter: Introduction of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Baker Street; Relocation of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Wykes Road; Removal of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on specified lengths of Chestnut Avenue, Briar Crescent and Whipton Lane; Introduction of **Residents Parking Mon–Fri 8am–6pm Zone G and Zone S4** on specified lengths of Union Road. Residents, charity business occupier permits £30 annually, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30, business annual permits: 1st permit £30, 2nd permit £75, 3rd permit £150; guest house/hotel visitors permit £30 per batch of 20 permits, annual trade permits £45, short stay trade permits £60 for book of 20, daily trade permit £5, weekly trade permit £25, essential visitor and care worker permits are free

Exmouth: Introduction of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Salisbury Road

Ilfracombe: Introduction of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Chambercombe Park Road

Newton Abbot: Removal of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Alexandra Road

Teignmouth: Introduction of **Disabled Badge Holders At Any Time** on a specified length of Salisbury Terrace

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.
