

**Devon County Council (Bradley Road, Bovey Tracey)  
(Prohibition of All Vehicles) Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as Devon County Council (Bradley Road, Bovey Tracey) (Prohibition of All Vehicles) Order
- 2 Save as provided in article 3 no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the schedule
- 3 Nothing in article 2 prevents any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the specified road if the vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties

**Schedule Prohibition of All Vehicles**

*Lengths of roads in the parish of Bovey Tracey in the district of Teignbridge*

**Bradley Road** (Spur opposite Centenary Way) from a point 20 metres opposite, and east of the junction of Centenary Way in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 18 metres and on

**Bradley Road** (Spur opposite Centenary Way) from a point 50 metres opposite, and west of the junction of Centenary Way in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres
