

**Devon County Council (Cranbrook Station)
(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and One Way) Order**

Devon County Council make the following order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & of all other enabling powers

This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Cranbrook Station) **(Traffic Regulation)** Amendment Order _____”

1. Except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have these meanings assigned to them
 - bus** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
 - emergency service vehicle** means a vehicle being used for ambulance, coastguard, fire or police purposes in relation to an emergency or whilst in pursuit of duties
 - hackney carriage** has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976
 - postal packets** has the same meaning as defined in section 4(3) of the Postal Services Act 2000
2. Except as provided in Article 4 no person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1
3. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply if the vehicle is:
 - a bus
 - a hackney carriage
 - an emergency service vehicle
 - being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - requiring access to park in the off-highway railway land
 - an invalid carriage
 - requiring access to the pick up and drop off bay to pick up and drop off passengers to the railway station
 - being used for the delivery or collection of postal packets
4. Except as provided in Article 6 no person shall cause to be driven in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 other than in the direction specified in that schedule
5. Nothing in Article 5 shall apply to a mechanical road cleansing vehicle between midnight and 8 am

Schedule 1 Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Lengths of road in the Parish of Cranbrook in the District of East Devon

Burrough Fields (Spur Outside Cranbrook Station), Cranbrook

From the northern side of the access to the entrance of the western car park in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Burrough Fields (Spur leading to eastern car park)

Schedule 2 One Way

Lengths of road in the Parish of Cranbrook in the District of East Devon

Road Name	Length of Road	Direction
Burrough Fields (Spur Outside Cranbrook Station), Cranbrook	from the southern junction with Burrough Fields (Spur leading to eastern car park) in a south-westerly, north-westerly then north-easterly direction to its northern junction of that road	South-west bound then north-west bound then north-east bound.
