

Devon County Council (Marine Parade, Instow) (Residents Parking) Amendment Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in Instow

Limited Waiting 8am-6pm between 1 May and 30 Sep 1 Hour No Return Within 1 Hour on a specified length of Marine Parade

Limited Waiting 8am-6pm between 1 May and 30 Sep 2 Hours No Return Within 2 Hours on specified lengths of Marine Parade

Residents Parking 8am-6pm Zone A on specified lengths of Marine Parade and Lane End Road - residents permits £30 annually, annual trade permit £45 annually, short stay trade permits £60 per book of 20 permits, daily trade permit £5 (valid for 1 calendar day), weekly trade permit £25 (valid for 7 calendar days), care worker and essential visitor permits are free. Permit selection and prices stated are correct on date of publication but could be subject to change in the future.

Loading Only 8am-6pm on a specified length of Marine Parade

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.

statement of reasons

The proposal aims to introduce a new residents parking scheme that has been agreed for advertising, to improve access and to improve parking options for local residents.

The restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and to preserve/improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
