

Devon County Council (Queens Terrace, Exeter) (One Way) Order

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Queens Terrace, Exeter) (One Way) Order _____”
2. Save as provided in article 3 no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in column 1 of the schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 2
3. Nothing in article 2 applies if the vehicle is
 - (a) being used in an emergency for fire, police or ambulance purposes
 - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 6am-8am
4. Schedule 16 of ‘The County of Devon (Various Streets, St. David’s Hill Area, Exeter) (Traffic Regulation and Parking Places) Order 2004’ insofar as it relates to Queen’s Terrace is revoked
