## Devon County Council (Queens Terrace, Exeter) (One Way) Order

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

- 1. This order comes into force and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Queens Terrace, Exeter) (One Way) Order "
- Save as provided in article 3 no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable
  in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in column 1 of the
  schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column
- 3. Nothing in article 2 applies if the vehicle is
  - (a) being used in an emergency for fire, police or ambulance purposes
  - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
  - (c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle between the hours of 6am-8am
- 4. Schedule 16 of 'The County of Devon (Various Streets, St. David's Hill Area, Exeter) (Traffic Regulation and Parking Places) Order 2004' insofar as it relates to Queen's Terrace is revoked
