

Various Roads, Starcross - Proposed Vehicle Prohibition, No Right Turn & Control of Waiting

Devon County Council propose to make these under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Starcross) (Control of Waiting) Amendment Order 5873 to introduce for Starcross: NO WAITING AT ANY TIME on **Road from The Strand to Cofton Cross:** the west side from a point 44 metres south of its junction with Royal Way for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction and the west side from its junction with Royal Way southwards for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction; **The Strand:** the west side from the extended southern building line of The View southwards to the extended southern building line of Harpridge and NO WAITING MON-SAT 8AM-6PM on **The Strand:** the west side from the extended southern building line of Isca southwards to the extended northern building line of Compass Cottage

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Starcross) (Traffic Regulation) Order 5880 to introduce for Starcross: PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES on **Church Street:** from its junction with The Strand for a distance of 2 metres and PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN from **New Road into The Strand**

Statement of Reason:

The Starcross Enhancement Scheme is intended to improve pedestrian safety on the footways and improve traffic flow on the A379 through Starcross, with a few modest enhancements such as footway widening and narrowing of the carriageway. As part of the enhancement scheme, it is proposed to introduce waiting restrictions on some sections of the A379 to restrict parking through the busiest times of the day to help improve traffic flow exiting the narrow section, but still allowing parking adjacent the public house in the evenings and providing additional areas for large vehicles to pass aiding traffic flow.

In addition, it is proposed to introduce a no right turn out of New Road, which will help to reduce turning movements on the most constrained section of The Strand at the pinch point at the Pillars and introduce a prohibition of motor vehicle order at the junction of Church Street with The Strand to aid traffic flow on The Strand. Vehicles wishing to access The Strand will have to go out via Royal Way or New Road (northwards only).

Specifically, the order will facilitate the passage on the road or any other of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and preserving or improving the amenities of the area which the road runs through.
