Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in Newton Abbot

#### **Restricted Road**

Ringslade Road, from a point 58 metres north of its junction with Highweek Village to a point 151 metres north of that junction

#### **30mph Speed Limit**

A382, from a point 19 metres north of its junction with Whitehill Close to a point 199 metres northwest of its junction with Whitehill Road

Exeter Road, from its junction with the A382 to a point 49 metres north-west of that junction

Ringslade Road, from a point 151 metres north of its junction with Highweek Village to a point 238 metres north of that junction

### **Speed Derestriction**

A382, from a point 89 metres east of its junction with Ringslade Road to a point 20 metres north west of its junction with Forches Cross Road

# **Statement of Reason**

As part of the A382 Improvement Scheme, the A382 has recently been widened and realigned and streetlights added on a section of the A382 from the new roundabout at the junction of Ringslade Road to Forches Cross Road. It is proposed to introduce a derestriction order on this section of road to maintain the national speed limit on this street lit section.

The existing 30mph speed limit coming out of Newton Abbot has been extended by approximately 159 metres as an interim design for the next phase of improvements which will include connecting West Golds Way by the hospital to the newly widened A382.

In addition, the 30mph speed limit has been extended out on Ringslade Road from Highweek Village to improve road safety in the area.

Specifically, the order will facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and will preserve or improve the amenities of the area which the road runs through.
