

**Devon County Council
(Moreleigh Cross to Stanborough, Halwell)
(Prohibition of All Vehicles Except Access) Order**

Devon County Council makes the following order under sections 1, 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

- 1 Except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have these meanings assigned to them **emergency service vehicle** means a vehicle being used for ambulance, coastguard, fire or police purposes in relation to an emergency or whilst in pursuit of duties
- 2 Nothing in this order applies to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
- 3 Except as provided in article 4 it is a contravention for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the schedule
- 4 Nothing in article 3 applies if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) an emergency service vehicle;
 - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) being used to access land or premises on or adjacent to the length of highway;
 - (d) being used for a specified period in connection with any of the following operations on or adjacent to that length of road:-
 - (i) building industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment; or
 - (iv) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of that length of road
