Limited Waiting 10am-6pm between 15 Mar and 31 Oct 1 Hour No Return Within 2 Hours (Exemption for Residents Zone A Permit Holders) on specified lengths of South Street

Limited Waiting 8am-9pm between 15 Mar and 31 Oct 20 Minutes No Return Within 2 Hours on a specified length of The Esplanade

Pay & Display 30 mins 50p, 1 hour £1.30, 2 hours £2.50, 3 hours £3.70, 4 hours £4.90: 8am-midnight between 15 Mar and 31 Oct Max Stay 4 Hours on specified lengths of The Esplanade

**Residents Parking At Any Time Zone A** on specified lengths of Arlington Place and South Street - residents, charity business occupier permits £30 annually, annual trade permits £45, short stay trade permits £60 for book of 20, daily trade permit £5, weekly trade permit £25; business permit annual cost: 1<sup>st</sup> permit £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> permit £75, 3<sup>rd</sup> permit £150; visitor permits £30 per batch of 30, essential visitor permits and care worker permits are free

Disabled Badge Holders Only 8am-midnight on specified lengths of The Esplanade
