Devon County Council (“Council”) makes the following order under sections 1, 2, 4, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“Act”) and of all other enabling powers

**PART 1 GENERAL**

- 1.1 This order comes into force \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Various Road, Bideford) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles & One-Way) Order \_\_\_\_\_”
- 1.2 Except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have these meanings assigned to them
- Council Permit** means a permit issued by the Council or its agent which will refer to one vehicle only and will be valid for a specified period. At all times that the vehicle is within a restricted area the permit must be displayed in either of the two following locations
- 1 in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen,
  - 2 in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the permit is to be exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle
- emergency service vehicle** means a vehicle being used for ambulance, coastguard, fire or police purposes in relation to an emergency or whilst in pursuit of duties
- 1.3 In this order
- (a) any reference to an enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or any successive enactment
  - (b) any reference to an article, part or table refers to the corresponding article, part or table in this order unless stated and except where the context otherwise requires a reference to a numbered or lettered paragraph or sub-paragraph, is a reference to the paragraph or sub-paragraph bearing that number or letter in the article or table, or (in the case of a sub-paragraph) paragraph in which the reference occurs
- 1.4 Nothing in this order applies to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
- 1.5 The provisions of this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from the provisions of any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
- 1.6 The orders in part 5 are revoked as specified

PART 2 ONE WAY: Mill Street

2.1 Except as provided in article 2.2 no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in any of the road specified in column 1 of table 2 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 3

2.2 Nothing in article 2.1 applies to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle

PART 3 PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES: Cooper Street & Lower Gunstone

3.1 Except as provided in article 3.2 it is a contravention for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in table 3

3.2 Nothing in article 3.1 applies if the vehicle is

- (a) an emergency service vehicle
- (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- (c) being used in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by or on behalf of the Council or the Chief Officer of Police
- (d) being used with a Council Permit in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to that length of road provided it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road
  - (i) being used for refuse collection
  - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
  - (iii) building industrial or demolition operations
  - (iv) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment
  - (v) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of that length of road

PART 4 PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES BETWEEN 10AM & 4PM  
(WITH EXEMPTIONS): Mill Street & Lower Gunstone

- 4.1 Except as provided in article 4.2 it is a contravention for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed between 10AM and 4PM in the lengths of roads specified in table 4
- 4.2 Nothing in article 4.1 applies if the vehicle is
- (a) an emergency service vehicle
  - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
  - (c) being used in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by or on behalf of the Council or the Chief Officer of Police
  - (d) being used with a Council Permit in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to that length of road provided it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road
    - (i) being used for refuse collection
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
    - (iii) building industrial or demolition operations
    - (iv) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment
    - (v) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of that length of road
  - (e) a security vehicle, or a vehicle being used with a Council Permit, for the carriage of money to and from a bank, building society or business premises
  - (f) vehicles being used to gain access to premises adjacent to those lengths of road in connection with a funeral
  - (g) being used in connection with baptism, wedding or funeral services or other religious ceremonies at the Bideford Baptist Church provided that notice of any such service or ceremony is given to the police not less than 24 hours before such service or ceremony is due to commence
