

**Devon County Council (Various Roads, East Devon)
(30mph Speed Limit and Restricted Road) Order**

Devon County Council make this order under sections 82, 83, 84 and part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“Act”) and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Various Roads, East Devon) (30mph Speed Limit and Restricted Road) Order ”
2. The lengths of road specified in schedule 1 are restricted roads for the purpose of section 81 of the Act
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the lengths of road specified in schedule 2
4. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
5. The County of Devon (C60 Weston Lane, and Side Roads, Weston, Awliscombe/Gittisham) (Restricted Roads) Order 2000 is revoked in its entirety

SCHEDULE 1 Restricted Road

Lengths of road in Gittisham in the district of East Devon

Hayne Lane from a point 3 metres south-east of its junction with the access leading to Old Elm Road to a point 27 metres north-west of its junction with Devonshire Road

Devonshire Road from its junction with Hayne Lane to a point 108 metres north-east of that junction

SCHEDULE 2 30mph Speed Limit

Lengths of road in Buckerell, Gittisham and Weston in the district of East Devon

Road From Western House to Redacre from its junction to Road from Weston Cross to Cherry Bridge for a distance of 128 metres

Road From Weston Cross to Cherry Bridge from Western Cross for a distance of 194 metres north of its junction with Road from Weston House to Redacre

Road From Weston Cross to Kings Arms Farm for the entire length
