Statement of Reasons

Following a review of the bridge over the Railway Line at East Cliff Walk, it has been identified that the structure can only take vehicles up to 3 tonnes in weight. Whilst this has been informally signed in the past it is now proposed to formalise this arrangement. When the issue was identified a Temporary Weight Limit (TTRO2139607) was introduced until the 4th October 2022 to ensure that safety is maintained until this matter can be resolved.

Specifically, if made, the order will prevent danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.
