Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce **No Waiting At Any Time** on specified lengths of Clyst Road, Denver Road, Elm Grove Road, Exeter Road, Ferry Road & Orchard Way; **Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-5pm 1 Hour No Return Within 2 Hours** on specified lengths of Fore Street.; **Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 9am-5pm 1 Hour No Return Within 2 Hours (Exemption for Residents Zone T1 Permit Holders)** on specified lengths of Follett Road; **Pay & Display (Tariff Topsham A) 9am-5pm\* (Exemption for Residents Zone T1 Permit Holders): 1 hour £0.50; 2 hours £1.30; 3 hours £1.80; 4 hours £2.50; over 4 hours £3.30 on specified lengths of Clyst Road, Elm Grove Road, Ferry Road, High Street & Nelson Close; <b>Residents Parking (Zonal) 9am-5pm Zone T1** on specified lengths of Ashford Road, Belvedere Close, Berwick Avenue, Denver Close, Dunlins Walk, Gordon Road, Grove Hill, Haldon Close, Hamilton Road, Newcourt Road, Nurseries Close, Orchard Way, Pintail Lane, Plover Close, Pound Close, Pound Lane, Powderham Close, Retreat Road, Riverside Road, Service Road for Nos 39 to 83 Exeter Road, Sunhill Avenue, Sunhill Lane, The Chase & The Mede; **Residents Parking 9am-5pm Zone T1** on specified length of Denver Road; **Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time** on specified lengths of Hamilton Road & Newcourt Road.

Residents, charity business occupier permits £30 annually, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30, business permits annual cost: 1<sup>st</sup> permit £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> permit £75, 3<sup>rd</sup> permit £150; annual trade permit £45, short stay trade permits £60 per book of 20, daily trade permit £5, weekly trade permit £25; guest house/hotel visitors permit £30 per batch of 20 permits; essential visitor and care worker permits are free.

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles.
