

**Devon County Council (Broadway Road & Tweenways, Kingsteignton)
(No Waiting at Any Time) Amendment Order**

Devon County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to introduce in Kingsteignton:

No Waiting At Any Time on Broadway Road:

the north-east side from a point 47 metres north-west of its junction with Tweenways to a point 59 metres south-east of that junction; the south-west side from its junction with Amberley Gardens for a distance of 53 metres in a north-westerly direction and the south-west side from the entrance to Kingsteignton Athletic Football Club to a point 13 metres south-east of its junction with Andor Avenue

and on **Tweenways:**

the north-west side from its junction with Broadway Road for a distance of 25 metres in a north-easterly direction and the south-east side from its junction with Broadway Road for a distance of 23 metres in a north-easterly direction

There will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles

Statement of Reasons

As part of the new development at Amberley Gardens at Broadway Road, a new footway crossover has been constructed to the new residential development. The proposals have also incorporated a new section of footway and a priority narrowing system on Broadway Road.

As part of the scheme, it is proposed to introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions to prevent obstructive and inappropriate parking around the junctions in the vicinity of the new development to maintain visibility and through the narrow section of Broadway Road.

Specifically, the order will preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
