

Devon County Council (West Street, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Order

Devon County Council make this order under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as "Devon County Council (West Street, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Order _____"
2. In this order **pedal cycle** means a pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle not being in either case a motor vehicle
3. Save as provided in article 4 no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the length of the road specified in schedule 1 in the direction specified in column 3 of that schedule
4. Nothing in article 3 applies if the vehicle is:
 - (a) being used in an emergency for fire, police or ambulance purposes
 - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle
 - (d) a pedal cycle
5. The order listed in schedule 2 is revoked as indicated in that schedule
