EAST THE WATER: **No Waiting At Any Time** on specified lengths of Ayres Close, Heathfield Road and Torrington Lane; **No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-4pm** on a specified length of Access to Alverdiscott Industrial Estate Lane;

GREAT TORRINGTON: **No Waiting At Any Time** on a specified length of South Street; **Limited Waiting 8am-5pm 1 Hour No Return Within 2 Hours** on a specified length of South Street;

HARTLAND: No Waiting At Any Time on specified lengths of The Square; Loading Only Mon-Sat 7.30am-10.30am on a specified length of Fore Street;

HIGH BICKINGTON: No Waiting At Any Time on specified lengths of Barton Meadow Road;

HOLSWORTHY: No Waiting At Any Time on specified lengths of Chapel Street;

MERTON: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Road From Lakes Cross To Grange Lane;

NORTHAM: No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Bay View Road;
