

Devon County Council (Quay Hill, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Amendment Order

Devon County Council makes the following order under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Quay Hill, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Order"
2. The schedules in part 1 are added to Devon County Council (Traffic Regulation & On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2020 as amended and the lengths of road in part 2 are revoked from the corresponding schedules of that order
3. In this order
pedal cycle means a pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle not being in either case a motor vehicle
4. Save as provided in article 5 no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the length of the road specified in schedule 1 in the direction specified in column 3 of that schedule
5. Nothing in article 4 applies if the vehicle is:
 - (a) being used in an emergency for fire, police or ambulance purposes
 - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle
 - (d) a pedal cycle
6. The order listed in schedule 2 is revoked as indicated in that schedule.
