

Various Roads, Topsham - Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and 20mph Speed Limit

Devon County Council propose to make these under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce:

Devon County Council (Apsham Grange Area, Topsham) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 5945 Introduce:

20MPH speed limit on specified lengths of; Artillery Avenue, Clyst Road, Engineers Road, George Rise, Marine Drive, Token Place, Victoria Mead

Devon County Council (Clyst Road, Topsham) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 6003 to introduce:

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on Clyst Road, Topsham from a point 100 metres south of its junction with Whitehall Lane to a point 47 metres north of its junction with Highfield

Statement of Reasons

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Due to the development of a new road in the area, vehicular access will no longer be required along a section of Clyst Road and therefore it is proposed to introduce a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles to restrict access to the road and to improve cycle/walking facilities as shown on the attached plan. The order will avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

20mph Speed Limit

It is proposed to introduce a 20mph speed limit to include the new public highway within the Artillery Avenue Area to formalise speed limit restrictions and reduce the speed of traffic through the residential area. The order will avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
