

**Devon County Council (Castle Street, Combe Martin) (No Waiting At Any Time)
Amendment Order**

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce No Waiting At Any Time on a specified length of Castle Street, Combe Martin. There will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to picking up/setting down passengers, loading/unloading goods and disabled persons vehicles

statement of reasons

As part of the new retail development the adjacent footway is being widened into the carriageway. This means the road is no longer wide enough to permit parking and through traffic, therefore it is proposed to extend the No Waiting At Any Time to prevent on-street parking. The area of the restriction will also allow local bus services board and alight passengers on to the footway.

The restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
