Devon County Council (Various Roads, Bovey Tracey) (School Streets) Experimental Order 2022

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("Act") and of all other enabling powers

- This order comes into force 8th September 2022 and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Various Roads, Bovey Tracey) (School Streets) Experimental Order 2022"
- The Director of Climate Change, Environment and Transport at Devon County Council or someone authorised by that officer, after consultation with the chief officer of police, is an authorised person for the purpose of modifying or suspending this order or any provisions of it under section 10 of the Act if it appears to them essential for any of the reasons stated in section 10(2) of the Act
- 3 In this order:

disabled person's badge has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000

delivery and **collection** in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection

disabled person's vehicle means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled persons badge and is a vehicle which immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by the Local Authorities' Traffic orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 to be included in an order under the 1984 Act has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or has been or is to be used for carrying disabled person's as passengers

emergency service vehicle means a vehicle being used for ambulance, coastguard, fire or police purposes in relation to an emergency or whilst in pursuit of duties

goods includes postal packets of any description and the collection and delivery in relation to any goods including the checking of the goods for the purpose of delivery and collection

postal packets has the same meaning as defined in section 4(3) of the Postal Services Act 2000

private hire vehicle means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to seat fewer than eight passengers other than a hackney carriage or public service vehicle which is provided for hire with the services of a driver for the purpose of carrying passengers

resident means a person whose usual residence or second home is at a property situated on the specified roads listed in schedule

school transport vehicle means a Bus, Taxi or Private Hire Vehicle contracted by the Council to take children to or from school, fronting or adjacent to the specified roads

taxi means a licenced taxi as described in section 13(3) (a) of the Transport Act 1985

- 4. Except as provided for in article 5, no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the roads specified in column 1 during the time period specified in column 2 of the schedule
- 5. Nothing in article 4 shall apply if the vehicle is
 - a) an emergency service vehicle
 - b) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) being used in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to those lengths of road:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment; or
 - (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those lengths of road
 - d) being used for the delivery or collection of postal packets to premises in or adjacent to those lengths of road
 - e) being used by residents, visitors or deliveries to residential properties within the specified roads
 - f) a disabled persons vehicle
 - g) a school transport vehicle
 - h) exiting the specified roads
