Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for Hemyock

Devon County Council (Hartley Drive, Hemyock) (One Way) Order 5997 to introduce:

One Way on a specified length of Hartley Drive

Devon County Council (Hartley Drive, Hemyock) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 6004 to introduce:

20MPH speed limit on the entire length of Hartley Drive

Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to formalise the One-Way System along sections of Hartley Drive, Hemyock that have been implemented by the developers & to extend the 20mph speed limit within Hemyock to include the entire length of Hartley Drive to reduce the speed of traffic through the residential area.

The order will avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
