Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 1 Hour No Return Within 1 Hour (Exemption for Residents Permit Holders) on a specified length of Newton Road.

Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to remove a 6m section of limited waiting in front of an existing access and this section will be unrestricted. These proposals will maintain access across the dropped kerb onto the property.

The restrictions are proposed to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
