Statement of Reasons

This order is being requested due to highway safety concerns over the junction between Road Southwest of Iron Letters Cross (Oxenpark Lane) and the B3230 (Iron Letters Cross), which has no sideways visibility and has seen several accidents and near misses. It is proposed to completely close off the road at the junction with the B3230 by the installation of a hedge which will restrict all road users, including pedestrians, from entering or leaving the road. The remaining length of road would be covered by a prohibition of all vehicles except for access to the adjacent land, controlled by a gate across the highway

Specifically, the order will prevent the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road
