

Devon County Council (Filham, Ugborough) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1, 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Filham, Ugborough) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order _____”
2. Except as provided in article 3 no person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the schedule
3. Nothing in article 2 prevents any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the specified lengths of road if the vehicle is
 - a. an emergency service vehicle
 - b. being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c. being used in connection with maintaining the properties bounding the specified lengths of road

Schedule Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Length of roads in the parish of Ugborough, district of South Hams

C157 (Road from Cross in Hand to Peekmill Bridge Cross) from its junction with “Davids Lane” in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 164 metres

C157 (Road from Cross in Hand to Peekmill Bridge Cross) from its junction with “Road South from Filham Cross” in a south-easterly direction for direction for a distance of 179 metres

Z1921 (Track from North Filham towards A38) from its junction with C157 (Road from Cross in Hand to Peekmill Bridge Cross) in a southerly direction for distance of 49 metres
