

**Devon County Council (Road from Providence House to Chapners Cross, Witheridge)
(30mph Speed Limit) Order**

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce in Witheridge

30mph Speed Limit on the Road from Providence House to Chapners Cross, from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Road from Doctors Corner to Witheridge (using centre-line) to a point 61 metres south-east of that junction

Statement of Reasons

As a result of the new development at Willow Rise, it is proposed that the existing 30mph speed limit is extended out to tie up with the Witheridge name plate. The proposed extension will reduce the speed of traffic on approach to the village and adjacent development. This will improve road safety. We are proposing to extend the 30mph speed limit by Traffic Order approximately 65 metres south-east from the existing 30 mph terminal signs. Specifically, the order will preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
