- Devon County Council (Cullompton, Halberton, Sampford Peverell & Willand) (Weight & Length Restriction) Order 2018

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) is to formalise weight limit exemptions that currently occur when the A30 or M5 is closed, through a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO). Therefore, it is proposed to amend the original Weight Restriction TROs to allow such vehicles to proceed on the diversion routes without the need of a TTRO on each occurrence, saving on National Highways and Devon County Council's administrative time spent on the TTRO, as well as the financial costs associated.

The restrictions are proposed for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
