Devon County Council (Magdalen Road, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Experimental Order 2023

Devon County Council make the following order under sections 9, 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force 27th May 2023 and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Magdalen Road, Exeter) (One-Way with Contraflow Cycling) Experimental Order 2023"
- 2 In this order **pedal cycle** means a pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle not being in either case a motor vehicle
- 3 Save as provided in article 4 no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the length of the road specified in the schedule other than in the direction specified in column 3 of the schedule
- 4 Nothing in article 3 applies if the vehicle is
 - a) being used in an emergency for fire, police or ambulance purposes
 - b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle
 - d) a pedal cycle
- The Director of Climate Change, Environment and Transport at Devon County Council or someone authorised by that officer, after consultation with the chief officer of police, is an authorised person for the purpose of modifying or suspending this order or any provisions of it under section 10 of the Act if it appears to them essential for any of the reasons stated in section 10(2) of the Act
