Devon County Council made this on 17th May under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to come into force 27th May for a maximum of 18 months to introduce in Exeter

One Way Except Cycles on Magdalen Road westwards from Denmark Road to Fairpark Road

The Council will consider whether the provisions should continue indefinitely and anyone may object to the making of a permanent order within 6 months from 27th May or if this order is subsequently varied by another order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act within 6 months of that variation or modification coming into force.

Objections stating the grounds on which they are made and other comments must be in writing to the address below or via **devon.cc/tro** Receipt of submissions may not be acknowledged but those received will be considered. If you make a submission, please be aware that your comments will be anonymised prior to being sent to Highway & Traffic Orders Committee (HATOC) members for consideration or being published on the Council's website. Your data may be shared within Devon County Council and with our partner agencies. Your personal details will be kept confidential in line with the Privacy Notice at **devon.cc/troprivacy** and will only be shared in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Notice or to comply with the Council's legal obligations.

If you wish to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions because it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with, you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the order was made apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Statement of Reasons

Following the introduction of the one way on Magdalen Road it is proposed to trial an extension to the junction of Fairpark Road to mitigate the impacts of displaced traffic onto Denmark Road.

The restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
