Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce:

Residents Parking At Any Time Zone A - specified lengths of Tors Road, Lynmouth

No Waiting At Anytime - specified lengths of Tors Road, Lynmouth

Pay by Phone 10 AM – 6PM - specified lengths of Tors Road, Lynmouth; **1 Hour - £1.50; 2 Hours - £2.40; 3 Hours – £3.60 and 4 Hours - £4.80**

Statement of Reasons
