### Statement of Reasons

Teignmouth Town Council are proposing these changes to extend the available pay and display timings and remove the no return element, allowing the public to make the most of the facilities at Bitton House. There is a proposal to increase the types of permits available, to make these more accessible and affordable to all those wishing to utilise the available parking.
