Devon County Council (Rydon Lane, Woodbury) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 1 & 2 and part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & of all other enabling powers.

- 1 This order comes into force and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Rydon Lane, Woodbury) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order "
- 2 Except as specified in Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, allow a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the schedule
- 3 Nothing in article 2 applies if the vehicle is
 - a) an emergency service vehicle
 - b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) being used for a specified period in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to that length of road
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (iii) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment
 - (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road
 - d) being used to access land or premises adjacent to that length of road
