

## **Devon County Council (Various Roads, Buckerell) (30mph Speed Limit) Order**

Devon County Council make this order in exercise of powers under sections 82, 83, 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

- 1** This order comes into force \_\_\_\_\_ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Various Roads, Buckerell) (30mph Speed Limit) Order \_\_\_\_\_”
- 2** No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the schedule
- 3** Devon County Council (East Devon) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limits) Order 2012 is revoked in so far as it relates to the parish of Buckerell
- 4** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011

### **Schedule 30mph Speed Limit**

*Lengths of roads in the parish of Buckerell in the District of East Devon*

Road From Beats Close To Mandolin Winds - from its junction with Road Past Treaslake Farm to a point 43 metres north of the northern building line of The Old Village Hall

Road From Meadowside To Glebe Cottages - Entire Length

Road From Orchards Cross To Buckerell Cross – from its junction with Road From Beats Close To Mandolin Winds to a point 20 metres north from the centre of its junction with Road Past Curscombe Farm

Road Past Treaslake Farm - from a point 32 metres south-west of the south western building line of Treaslake Farm to its junction with Road From Beats Close To Mandolin Winds
