

Devon County Council (New North Road, Exeter) (One Way & Contraflow Bus Lane) Order

Devon County Council make the following order under sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

- 1 This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as "Devon County Council (New North Road, Exeter) (One-Way & Contraflow Bus Lane) Order _____"
- 2 In this order
bus lane means such areas of carriageway specified within this order which are bounded by the kerb line of that road and on the other side by the road marking complying with diagrams 1048.5 and 1049A specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
emergency service vehicle means a vehicle being used for ambulance, coastguard, fire or police purposes in relation to an emergency or whilst in pursuit of duties
excursion or tour has the same meaning given in section 137(1) of the Transport Act 1985
local bus means a public service vehicle used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour
local service has the meaning given in section 2 of the Transport Act 1985
pedal cycle means a pedal bicycle or pedal tricycle not being in either case a motor vehicle
public service vehicle has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981
- 3 Nothing in this order applies to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform
- 4 Save as provided in article 5 no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in a length of the road specified in schedule 1 in the direction other than that specified in column 3 of that schedule
- 5 Nothing in article 4 applies if the vehicle is
 - a) an emergency service vehicle
 - b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle between midnight and 8am
 - d) using the contraflow bus lane defined in article 6
- 6 Save as provided in articles 7 and 8 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a local bus travelling in the direction specified in column 3 of schedule 2; to enter, or wait or proceed in a bus lane specified in schedule 2
- 7 Nothing in article 6 applies if that vehicle is
 - a) a pedal cycle
 - b) an emergency service vehicle
 - c) a mechanical road cleansing vehicle between midnight and 8am
- 8 Nothing in article 6 makes it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to enter, wait or proceed in the bus lane for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to
 - a) be used for the removal of an obstruction to traffic
 - b) be used in the service of a local authority or water authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that whilst being used it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the bus lane
 - c) avoid an accident
