## Devon County Council (Various Roads, Dawlish) (20mph & Restricted Roads) Order

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under section 82, 83, 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers

- 1. This order comes into force on and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Various Roads, Dawlish) (20mph & Restricted Roads) Order "
- 2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads specified within schedule 1
- 3. The lengths of roads specified in schedule 2 are restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act
- 4. The orders specified in schedule 3 are revoked in their entirety
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
