

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Uffculme) (20mph Speed Limit & Restricted Roads) Order

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under sections 82, 83, 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force on _____ and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Various Roads, Uffculme) (20mph Speed Limit & Restricted Roads) Order"
2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads specified within schedule 1
3. The lengths of road specified in schedule 2 are restricted roads for the purpose of section 81 of the Act
4. The Devon County Council (Restricted Roads) (No 15) (East) Order 1976 is revoked in its entirety
5. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011

SCHEDULE 1: 20MPH SPEED LIMIT

Lengths of road at Uffculme in the District of Mid Devon

The roads listed below are included for the entire length of the highway:

Appletree Close, Ashley Close , Belle Vue Rise, Caumont Close, Clarke Close, Coldharbour, College Green, Commercial Road, Culm Haven, Culm Valley Way, East Street, Eastfield Orchard, Fore Street, High Street, Highland Park, Highland Terrace, Manor Close, Markers Road, Meadow View, Mill Street, Orchard Close, Pathfields, Pippins Field, Road from Russet Close to Coldharbour, Russett Close, The Spinney and The Square

And the specified lengths of road are listed below:

Ashley Road

From its junction with High Street to a point 23 metres north-east of its junction with Ashley Close

Bridge Street

From its junction with Fore Street to a point 140 metres south-east of its junction with Denners Way

Chapel Hill

From its junction with High Street to a point 483 metres north-west of that junction

Clay Lane

From its junction with Ashley Road to a point 82 metres north-west of its junction with Clay Court

Kitwell Street

For the extent of the public highway

Markers

From its junction with Markers Road for the extent of the public highway

Road From Bridwell Lodge to Selgars Cottages

From its junction with Commercial Road to a point 36 metres south-west of its junction with the Russett Close

Road From Mill Cottages to Oaklands

From its junction with Coldharbour to a point 50 metres south of that junction
