- No Waiting At Any Time in specified lengths of Hill Lane & Vaughan Road
- Car Club Vehicles Only At Any Time in a specified length of Hill Lane

Devon County Council (Hill Lane, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 6152

 Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on Hill Lane from a point 4 metres north of the southern property boundary of 333 Pinhoe Road to the northern end of the road

Under the Highways Act 1980 it is proposed to install in Exeter

FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP – 75mm high, 5.4 metres long and full width of the carriageway and to be constructed on Vaughan Road, centred 80 metres south-east of its junction with Pinhoe Road

FLAT TOP ROAD HUMP – 75mm high, 5.4 metres long and full width of the carriageway and to be constructed on Summer Lane, centred 7 metres north of its junction with Pinhoe Road

statement of reasons

As part of 'The Gardens' development on Vaughan Road it is proposed to prohibit motor vehicles at the northern end of Hill Lane to improve access to the new development for cycles and pedestrians. It is also proposed to introduce two road humps in the nearby area, one on Summer Lane and one on Vaughan Road. Alongside this, it is also proposed to introduce No Waiting At Any Time along Vaughan Road to act as junction protection for a new access into the development. On Hill Lane, the development will be shortening the carriageway and it is proposed to realign and extend the No Waiting At Any Time to prevent obstructive parking in the turning head area, as well as introducing two Car Club Bays in a new layby.

Specifically, the restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, will facilitate the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and will preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
