Devon County Council ("Council") makes the following order under sections 1, 2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Southernhay Area, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Amendment Order

2. Devon County Council (City Centre Area, Exeter) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023 is amended as follows

Insert Part 22A

3. After Part 22, insert

"PART 22A - PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES: Southernhay East

- 22A.1 Except as provided in article 22A.2 it is a contravention for a person to cause or permit a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Table 22A
- 22A.2 Nothing in article 22A.1 applies if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) an emergency service vehicle;
 - (b) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties:
 - (c) being used with a Council permit for other essential purposes;
 - (d) in connection with a procession, with Council approval;
