

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Dolton) (20mph Limits & Restricted Roads) Order

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under sections 82, 83, 84 & part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') & of all other enabling powers

1. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in schedule 1
2. The lengths of road specified in schedule 2 are restricted roads for the purpose of section 81 of the Act.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
4. The Devon County Council (Restricted Roads) (Dolton) Order 1983 is revoked in its entirety
5. This order comes into force on _____ and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Various Roads, Dolton) (20mph Limits & Restricted Roads) Order"

SCHEDULE 1 – 20MPH LIMITS

Lengths of road at Dolton in the District of Torridge

The roads listed below are included for the entire length of the highway:

Aller Road, Chapel Street, Church Close, Church Street, Fore Street, Road Past Hilliers, South Street and The Paddocks

And the specified lengths of road are listed below:

Cleave Hill

From its junction with Church Street to a point 119 metres south-west of that junction

North Street

For the extent of the public highway

Rectory Road

From its junction with Fore Street to a point 9 meters south-west of its junction with Barfield Road

Road From Dennis Cross to Frosts Cross

From its junction with Rectory Road to a point 15 metres north of that junction

Stafford Road

From its junction with Road Past Hilliers to a point 37 metres south of that junction

The Square

For the extent of the public highway

West Lane

From its junction with The Square to a point 185 metres west of its junction with Wysteria Close

SCHEDULE 2 – RESTRICTED ROADS

Lengths of road at Dolton in the District of Torridge

Rectory Road

From its junction with Road From Rectory Road To Dolton Beacon Cross to a point 30 metres south-west of that junction

Road From Rectory Road To Dolton Beacon Cross

From its junction with Rectory Road to a point 110 metres north-east of that junction
