Devon County Council (Russell Street, Newtown, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under sections 1,2, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

PART 1 - GENERAL

- 1. This order comes into force on and may be cited as "Devon County Council (Russell Street, Newtown, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order "
- 2. Except as specified in article 3, no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, allow a motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in schedule 1
- 3. Nothing in article 2 applies if the vehicle is
 - a) being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - b) being used for a specified period in connection with any of the following operations in or adjacent to that length of road
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (iii) in connection with statutory undertakers plant or equipment
 - (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road
- 4. The order in schedule 2 is revoked as indicated in the second column of that schedule
